- No required minimum hours for a project.
- ROUTINE LABOR IS NOT NORMALLY APPROPRIATE FOR A PROJECT.
- PROJECT SHOULD NOT BE FOR A COMMERCIAL BUSINESS BUT THERE ARE EXCEPTIONS — ASK IF YOU ARE UNSURE.
- THE PROJECT MY NOT BE A FUNDRAISER BUT YOU MAY DO FUNDRAISING TO GET FUNDS FOR YOUR PROJECT
- NO MORE THAN ONE EAGLE CANDIDATE CAN RECEIVE CREDIT FOR WORKING ON THE SAME SERVICE PROJECT
- PROJECT CAN NOT BE DIRECTLY FOR BSA
- TYPICALLY CLOTHING, FOOD, BLOOD, ETC. DRIVES ARE NOT ALLOWED

EAGLE PROJECT -PLANNING AND COMPLETION - FUNDRAISING, IF NEEDED

- SEE WHAT YOUR SPONSOR IS WILLING TO PROVIDE
- You can get donations from your scout account, your family, from PEOPLE IN YOUR TROOP, AND YOUR SPONSOR WITHOUT FILLING OUT THE FUNDRAISING FORM
- If any of these people have a direct relationship with a company, you don't have to fill out the fundraising form

- THE COMMITTEE AND SCOUTMASTER WILL ASK YOU QUESTIONS ABOUT YOUR PROJECT AND GIVE YOU SUGGESTIONS FOR YOUR PROJECT.
- IF APPROVED, BOTH WILL SIGN YOUR PAPERWORK.

- ONCE YOU HAVE SIGNED APPROVAL FROM THE SPONSOR, THE COMMITTEE

- EMAIL MR. OLGIN AT <u>GREG OLGIN@YAHOO.COM</u> TO PRESENT AND GET COUNCIL APPROVAL. THEY MEET EVERY THIRD TUESDAY OF EACH MONTH AT THE AVON UNITED METHODIST CHURCH.
- THE PRESENTATION IS THE SAME AS WHAT YOU JUST DID FOR THE TROOP COMMITTEE/SCOUTMASTER APPROVAL.
- Make sure to bring the full y filled out Proposal part of the workbook and the 3 signatures to this meeting so you can get you 4th and last approval signature.
- ALWAYS KEEP TRACK OF ALL HOURS YOU HAVE SPENT ON THE PROJECT BUT DO NOT OFFICIALLY START TO WORK ON THE PROJECT UNTIL YOU HAVE YOUR 4 SIGNATURES.
